NEW VENUE FOR 2001 SOUTH WEST PACIFIC TEAMS

During the 2001 Summer Festival of Bridge in Canberra, the main teams competition, the South West Pacific Teams (aka the NOT), running from Monday 21st January until Australia Day, 26th January, will be held at the traditional Rydges Hotel Canberra and a new venue, the Hyatt Hotel Canberra.
