### NOTES:

- ◆ *States must determine and note on the entry form whether their nominees for the ABPC Stage II and the ANC Open, Womens & Senior Teams are entitled to receive Playoff Qualifying Points because they are qualified to represent Australia by birth or citizenship or by residence.*
- ◆ *Trophies presented at the 2002 ANC must be returned for display at ABF Headquarters.*
- ◆ *States are urged to book their requirements for the Functions on the entry form.*
- ◆ *This States Entry Form is available for download from the ABF web site, [www.abf.com.au](http://www.abf.com.au).*
- ◆ *ANC Team Systems must be submitted as electronic copy to [webinfo@abf.com.au](mailto:webinfo@abf.com.au) using the Edward Convention Card Editor. Further details are posted on the web site.*
- ◆ *The ABPC Closing Function and the Interstate Welcome Party and Draw have been combined into one function on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> July, 6.00pm. Entrants to Stage III/B of the ABPC receive complimentary tickets to this function.*

**Automatic Entries:** 2001 ANC Pairs Winners (Open, Women's, Youth, Senior, & Mixed on the attached trophy list) receive automatic entry to the 2002 ANC. They are not part of the State entry quota but must be listed on the entry form.

**Closing Date:** State ABPC & ANC entries close 4 weeks prior to commencement of the ANC - 4.00pm Friday June 21<sup>st</sup> 2002. Entries received after this date must be accompanied by a late entry fee of \$110.

*Australian Butler Pairs Championship:* Each state is entitled to nominate one pair in Stage II of each of the Open & Women's events, but not the Senior event, at \$290 per pair. Places not filled and vacancies caused by withdrawals after entries close revert to the pool for the progression from Stage I. States whose nominations qualify for Stage III are billed for the entry fee (\$150 per pair) at the conclusion of Stage II.

*Australian National Championship:*

- The ANC pairs events are all one-day events on Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup> at 1.30pm.
- The captain's meeting is on Sunday July 28<sup>th</sup> at 9.00am.
- The ANC Teams event starts on Sunday July 28<sup>th</sup> at 10.30 am and consists of 24-board matches

Each State is entitled to an Open, Women's, Youth\* & Senior\*\* team and three pairs (except NT, one pair) plus the holders and three reserve pairs in each of the Open, Women's, Youth\*, Senior\*\* & Mixed pairs. When entries close the field for each of the pairs (22 pairs) is: the holders, the winners of a qualifying event designated by the Convener, the nominations in state order, the reserves in state an nomination order, other places in the qualifying event designated by the Convener. After entries close a State may replace one player in a pair who is unavailable for significant cause by a player from the same state. Vacancies caused by all other withdrawals are filled from the reserve list. Note that States are fined \$50 for each player they nominate for the pairs events who withdraws within one week of that event unless that player is an entrant in both the ABPC Stage III and the ANC Teams.

The State order for 2002 is the order of ANC rotation in which States move left one place each year:

\*-Youth players must be born after 31-12-75, except as authorised by the Youth Committee

\*\*--Senior players must be born before 21-7-47 (ABPC), 27-7-47 (ANC Pairs) or 28-7-47 (ANC Teams).

**Systems:** All events at the 2002 Australian National Championships are subject to the ABF System Regulations as revised to 1st May 1998. A copy of these Regulations is available on application to the ANC Convener. These Regulations specify that systems must be described on ABF Standard System Cards. Players should use the Edwards convention card editor available on the web site, [www.abf.com.au](http://www.abf.com.au). For preference systems should be constructed in 12pt Times New Roman. It is the responsibility of the players to classify their system correctly; players in doubt about the correct classification of their system should consult the Convener prior to the closing date. It is the responsibility of the State Secretaries to ensure that the systems for their state's teams are transmitted by e-mail to [webinfo@abf.com.au](mailto:webinfo@abf.com.au). Systems are permitted as follows:

- YELLOW (Highly Unusual Methods): O & W ABPC Stages II & III, Senior Stage B and ANC Teams.
- RED (Highly Artificial Conventions), BLUE & GREEN systems: ANC Championship events.

*Defences:* (printed, typed or written legibly in black ink on one side of an A4 sheet) to a YELLOW system or to the opening calls that classify a system as RED may be used at the table under the conditions specified in the Supplementary Regulations.

**System Disclosure:** Failure to lodge a system before the deadline may bar a pair from using a RED or YELLOW system. For the ANC teams, in addition, a fine of \$110 is payable by the offending State.

**ABPC Stage II:** YELLOW systems must be lodged with the Chairman of the ABF Tournament Unit or CTD **AT THE LATEST** by 5.30pm on Sunday, 21<sup>st</sup> July 2002. The requirement (printed, typed or written legibly in black ink) is two identical current ABF Standard system cards providing an adequate summary of the system plus two copies of a maximum of two supplementary A4 sheets (one side only) plus five copies of the complete and detailed system notes.

**ANC Teams:** Systems must be received earlier than four weeks prior to the commencement of the ANC - 4.00pm Friday June 21<sup>st</sup> 2001. All Systems must be submitted by e-mail to [webinfo@abf.com.au](mailto:webinfo@abf.com.au) using the Edwards Convention Card Editor for the ABF Standard system card plus one side of a maximum of four supplementary A4 sheets. Complete and detailed notes must accompany any YELLOW system. A maximum of four RED and/or YELLOW systems per team is permitted. Each player must bring to the table a current ABF Standard system card, printed, typed or written legibly in black ink.
