OLD NEWS – DID YOU KNOW that research is confirming what many bridge players suspect already?

That playing bridge is great exercise for your brain! There is some evidence that one of the benefits of playing bridge prevents brain degeneration and lessens the incidence of Alzheimer's disease.

NEW NEWS – DID YOU KNOW ABOUT THE "BRIDGE FOR BRAIN RESEARCH CHALLENGE". The Prince of Wales Medical Research Institute (which has 120 staff working on brain research) partnered by the NSWBA and FABC launched the first "BRIDGE FOR BRAIN RESEARCH CHALLENGE" The aim of this challenge is to promote the benefits of playing bridge in keep8ing your mind active while, at the same time, raising funds for Alzheimer's research.

Last May, 711 bridge players participated in a simultaneous pairs event with commentary on the hand records by Ron Klinger and Val Cummings. As well as raising a significant amount for this worthy cause, the winners received prizes such as mobile phones and the best individual fund-raiser won a Barrier Reef cruise.

In 2005 the event will go national with red MP so get your local club to organise a heat or watch out for the chance to play in a heat in a club nearby. Remember the old adage "use it or lose it"
