Accommodation: A list of accommodation is enclosed with this entry form.

Parking: Parking is available at several parking stations within an easy walk of the venue. Early bird parking offers the best discount, so aim to park before 9.00am. Your parking voucher will allow only one entry and one exit.

Smoking: No smoking will be allowed in the playing or results areas. Smokers are able to smoke on the ground floor in the bar area or outside of the front door of the hotel.

Regulations

ABF Regulations and Supplementary Regulations will apply to Championship events - see www.abf.com.au. SABF regulations will apply to Congress events, and where the ABF Supplementary Regulations are silent – see www.abf.com.au. Note that:

1. System Disclosure

All pairs must provide two system cards to their opponents at the table. ANC players must use ABF Standard System Cards.

ANC teams must pre-lodge systems as required by ANC regulations.

Pairs intending to use a Yellow system in Stage 2 or 3 of the Open or Womens' Butler must lodge it as two identical ABF System Cards plus up to two pages of notes by 6.30pm on Sun 23 July 2006.

2. Butler Entry Conditions

Players who are eligible to represent Australia may enter all stages of the Australian Open, Women's and Seniors' Butler Pairs Championships, whether partnered by another eligible player or not.

If neither player is eligible to represent Australia, a pair may enter all stages of the Butler. But, the following limits apply to the number of such pairs accepted into later stages:

- In each of the Open and Women's, a maximum of 6 such pairs in Stage 2 and 4 such pairs in Stage 3.
- In the Seniors', a maximum of 4 such pairs in Stage B.

When applying these limits, ineligible pairs will be ranked the same way as for qualification generally.

To enter the Seniors' Butler, players must be born before 1 Jan 1950.

The sponsoring organisation reserves the right to refuse any entry which includes a player who does not qualify under the Conditions of Contest or who is in bad standing with any registered bridge club or association.

3. Playoff Qualifying Points.

PQPs are awarded to:

- all entrants in the Interstate Teams, with additional awards for 1st and 2nd.
- members of the first 6 eligible pairs in the Open, Women's and Seniors' Butlers.

In the Butlers, pairs are eligible for PQP if either/both players are eligible to represent Australia in Open, Womens' or Senior events as the case may be. To receive PQPs, players must attest their eligibility.

4. Master points

Gold master points will be awarded for all stages of the Butlers and all ANC Championship events, the ANC Swiss Pairs and the ANC Restricted Pairs.

5. General behaviour.

All players and spectators are expected to be neat and tidy at all times in the venue. SABF Tournament and Discipline regulations apply.

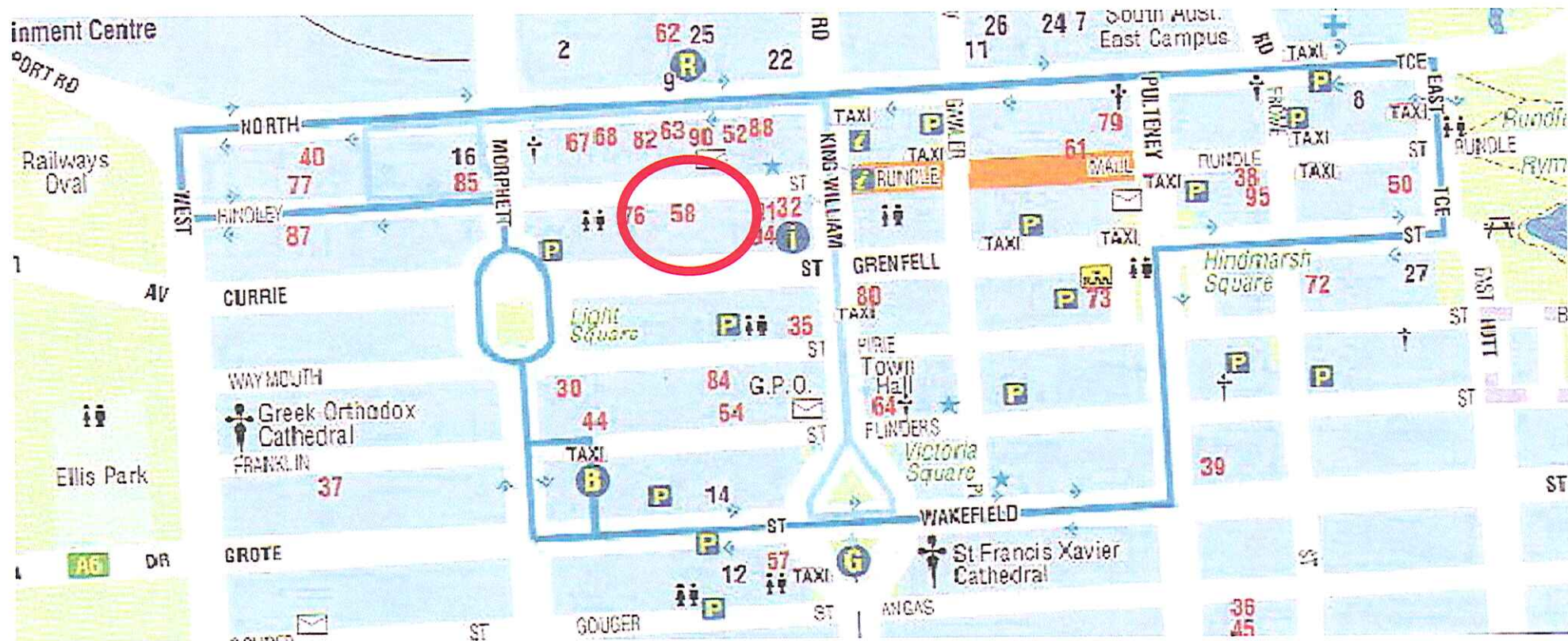
6. Mobile Phones and Pagers
