

	Basic System Description GREEN BLUE RED BROWN STICKER	GREEN  STANDARD, 5 card majors, short club
1C	Strong Club OR Natural 3+ AND 11 HCP	1C = natural OR can be as short as 2 if a weak balanced hand.
1D	Natural 3+ AND 11 HCP	
1H	Natural 4+ AND 11 HCP	Can be 4 card suit in 3 rd seat.
1S	Natural 4+ AND 11 HCP	Can be 4 card suit in 3 rd seat.
1NT	Any Balanced Hand fully contained within an 11 to 18 HCP range.	15-17 balanced (semi-balanced with some regularity). Weak NT in 4 th seat.
2C	Acol OR Strong AND/OR Natural 11-15 with or without Major	18-19 balanced (semi-balanced with some regularity)



	Basic System Description GREEN BLUE RED BROWN STICKER	BLUE <div style="text-align: center; width: 50px; height: 50px; margin: 0 auto;">  </div> Some hands that are suitable and easily rebid shapely 10 HCP will be opened.
1C	Strong Club OR Natural 3+ AND 11 HCP	Will be opened on all balanced hand without 5 major that are unsuited to opening 1NT (whose strength varies depending on position and vulnerability). Thus, could have 3-3-5-2 shape, etc. Will also be opened naturally on normal, unbalanced hands with 4+C.
1D	Natural 3+ AND 11 HCP	Always unbalanced and, if holding both minors, either suit could be longer.
1H	Natural 4+ AND 11 HCP	
1S	Natural 4+ AND 11 HCP	
1NT	Any Balanced Hand fully contained within an 11 to 18 HCP range.	
2C	Acol OR Strong AND/OR Natural 11-15 with or without Major


2H	Acol AND/OR Strong AND/OR Natural 11-15 with or without Major AND/OR A Weak Two Bid in H AND/OR 5+/5+ Colour/Rank/Odd	4+/4+ H&S (actual requirements vary with position and vulnerability).
2S	Acol AND/OR Strong AND/OR Natural 11-15 with or without Major AND/OR A Weak Two Bid in S AND/OR 5+/5+ Colour/Rank/Odd	
2NT	Strong AND/OR Minors AND/OR 5+/5+ Colour/Rank/Odd	20-22 balanced (semi-balanced with some regularity)

	1C-1D and 1C-1H show H and S respectively. Responder may choose to respond this way on any hand with 5+M (i.e. 0+HCP), or with any hand of 4M and about 3+HCP. Opener has many artificial continuations.
	1C-1S shows either a hand at most 3M that lacks invitational strength, OR any hand with 5+D as its primary feature that worth a game force.
	1D-1M-1NT is multi-way, showing either a normal 2D rebid OR any 3M raise OR various invitational or better hands with secondary C OR a one-suited D game-force.
	1H-1S-2C and 1M-1NT-2C are multi-way, showing either a normal 2M rebid OR any hand of 16+HCP.
	1NT-2C is a puppet to 2D (Keri).
	1NT-3X are transfer splinters.
	After they open 1C or 1D, when we are either <u>not vulnerable</u> or <u>not facing a passed hand</u> , we use X to show 15+HCP (with a step 1 artificial negative), 1NT as 6-14HCP takeout with 4+ in the other minor, 1-level overcalls natural with 6-14HCP but could be bad 4-card suits, the cheapest two jump overcalls show that suit and the one above it, the cuebid shows an unlimited two-suited hand with the two touching suits, and 2NT shows a strong hand with the non-touching suit and another suit.
	At trick one, third hand uses Obvious Shift signals, where (roughly) the card is natural attitude for a pre-defined obvious shift suit and does NOT relate to the suit led.
	Reverse Smith peters at notrump
	Journalist Leads
	3NT opening shows one of either a strong major-suit preempt, a four-level minor suit preempt or to play, depending on position and vulnerability
	4m opening shows either a minor suit preempt, a strong major-suit preempt, or a minor suit preempt accordingly

1NT	Any Balanced Hand fully contained within an 11 to 18 HCP range.	Note that we may <u>rarely</u> open a 15-17 balance hand containing a 5 card major.
