### NOTES:

- ◆ **CHANGE**            *ANC Pairs is 3 sessions – 2 on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1 on Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> August.*
- ◆ **CHANGE**            *ANC Teams commence Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> August with matches of 20 boards.*
- ◆ **CHANGE**            *States/Territories are urged to book their Victory Dinner tickets on this entry form - they attract a discount of \$5 per ticket.*
- ◆ **CHANGE**            *SYSTEM SUMMARY. 2008 ANC Team Systems must be disclosed in full using the Edwards ABF system card. It is the responsibility of the State/Territory Secretary to ensure that system summaries are completed accurately, identify the pairs by State/Territory and team category, collate and transmit the systems in a maximum of one e-mail per team to webmaster@abf.com.au before 4.00pm Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2008.*
- ◆ **CHANGE**            *FORMAT. The 2008 Senior ABPC consists of Stages A & B concurrent with Stages II & III of the Open & Womens ABPC. States are entitled to nominate one pair for Stage II of the Open & Womens categories.*
- ◆ **ELIGIBILIT**        *Youth eligibility is “born on or after 1-1-(current year – 26)”*
- ◆ *States/Territories must determine and note on the entry form whether their nominees for the ABPC Stage II and the ANC Open, Women’s & Senior Teams are entitled to receive Playoff Qualifying Points because they are qualified to represent Australia by birth or citizenship or by residence.*
- ◆ *States/Territories must determine the eligibility of their nominees for the ANC Senior and Youth Teams by noting their date of birth on the entry form.*
- ◆ *All fees include GST*
- ◆ *This Entry Form is available for download from the ABF web site, [www.abf.com.au](http://www.abf.com.au).*
- ◆ *Fines, payable to the James O'Sullivan Trust Fund, for late submission of an entry form or a system or an unauthorised withdrawal of a pair are \$220.*
- ◆ *Entry to the ANC pairs is open to any pair of players, irrespective of their state(s) of origin, who enter on the supplementary list as detailed in the ANC Brochure/Entry Form before 21<sup>st</sup> July 2008. Entry fee \$75 per pair.*

*Youth players must be born on or after 1-1-1982 except as authorised by the Youth Committee. Senior players must be born before 1-1-1951.*

### STATE/TERRITORY ENTRIES:

**Closing Date:** State/Territory ABPC & ANC entries close 4 weeks prior to commencement of the ANC - 4.00pm Friday June 27<sup>th</sup> 2008. Entries received after this date must be accompanied by the late entry fee of \$220.

*Australian Butler Pairs Championship:*

- Each State/Territory is entitled to nominate one pair for Stage II in each of the Open & Women's events. The entry fee of \$330 per pair entitles that pair to free entry to Stage I.
- Stage II places not filled and vacancies caused by withdrawals after entries close revert to the pool for the progression from Stage I.
- States/Territories whose nominations qualify to Stage III are invoiced for the Stage III entry fee (\$180 per pair) at the conclusion of Stage II.

*Australian National Pairs Championships:*

- The ANC pairs events are two-day events; Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> August at 10.30am & 2.45pm and Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> August at 10.30am.
- Age limits apply to Youth & Senior Events – see notes above.
- **Automatic Entries:** 2007 ANC Pairs Winners (Open, Women's, Youth, Senior, & Mixed on the attached trophy list) receive automatic entry to the 2008 ANC Pairs. They are not part of the State/Territory entry quota but must be listed on the entry form. The holders of the Youth trophy must be eligible as above.
- **Other Entries:** Each State/Territory is entitled to nominate three pairs plus the holders for free entry into each of the Open, Women's, Senior & Mixed pairs. After entries close States/Territories may replace one player in their nominations who is unavailable for significant cause by a player from the same State/Territory.
- **Youth Pairs:** Entry is unlimited.
- Note that States/Territories are fined \$220 for each pair they nominate for the pairs events who withdraws within one week of that event.

*Australian National Teams Championship:*

- The captains' meeting is at the conclusion of the second session of the ANC Pairs; Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> August (about 6-6.30)
- The ANC Teams event starts on Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> August at 2.45pm and consists of 20-board matches.
- Each State/Territory is entitled to an Open, Women's, Youth & Senior team.
- Age limits apply to Youth & Senior Events – see notes above.

**SYSTEMS:**

All events at the 2008 Australian National Championships are subject to the ABF System Regulations as revised to September 2006 which specify that systems must be described on ABF Standard System Cards.

Players are responsible for correct classification of their system; players in doubt about the correct classification of their system should consult the Convener prior to the closing date. Supplementary systems sheets and Defences should be printed, typed or written legibly in black ink on one side of an A4 sheet.

Each player must bring to the table a current ABF Standard system card with a detailed description of the system.

Systems are permitted as follows:

- Each team may register up to four systems but a pair is restricted to one YELLOW system
- YELLOW (Highly Unusual Methods). Open/Women/Senior ABPC Stages II/III, ANC Teams
- GREEN, BLUE, RED and BROWN Sticker systems are permitted in all events.

*Defences:* (printed, typed or written legibly in black ink on one side of an A4 sheet) to a YELLOW system or BROWN sticker convention may be used at the table under the conditions specified in the Supplementary Regulations.

**System Disclosure:** Failure to lodge a system before the deadline may bar a pair from using a BROWN Sticker or YELLOW system. For the ANC teams, in addition, the offending State/Territory pays a fine of \$220.

**ABPC Stage II/B YELLOW systems:** Two identical current system cards (ABF Standard or WBF) plus supplementary notes (maximum two A4 sheets, one side only) providing an adequate summary of the system plus five copies of the complete and detailed system notes must be lodged with the ABF Tournament Unit Chairman or CTD **AT THE LATEST** by 5.30pm on Sunday, 27<sup>th</sup> July 2008.

**ANC Teams:** Systems must be received earlier than four weeks prior to the commencement of the ANC teams - 4.00pm Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2008. All System summaries must be submitted

- ◆ before 4.00pm Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2008.
- ◆ as electronic copy in a maximum of one e-mail per team to [webmaster@abf.com.au](mailto:webmaster@abf.com.au)
- ◆ with pairs identified by State/Territory and team category.

Supplementary notes may be submitted on one side of a maximum of four A4 sheets. Complete and detailed notes must accompany any YELLOW system and five copies of these system notes must be lodged with the CTD before the captains' meeting.
