## OTHER NOTES

Raise of 4th suit promises 16+ (not necessarily 4 cards in suit). 'Up-the-line' responses to 2NT/3C inquiry over opening 2 bid (higher bids show better hand), except after 2D opening (where 3C/3D show a better hand than 3H/3S).

Cue bids are 'up the line' (first-round controls before second), except that responder to 2C opening may show second-round controls first in a co-operative sequence.
