## OTHER NOTES

INT overcall: 15-18, stopper; in re-open position: 12-15, stopper not required Defense to NT:

2C - 5+ diamonds (or also 4major+5minor if weak NT)
2D - 5+ hearts; 2H - 4+ in both majors
2S - 5+ spades; 2NT - 5+ clubs; 3C - 5+/4+ in minors; 3D-good 5+/5+ majors
Double: 14+ penalty oriented if NT weak, or 4major +5 minor if NT strong
