Leading Player Missing - Foul Play Suspected

Our bridge correspondent reports that an unnamed male member of the Victorian open team has mysteriously disappeared while visiting Crocodylus Park accompanied by several NT players. Police have not released the missing person's name at this stage, as foul play is suspected and next-of-kin have not been notified.

David Beauchamp, the NT's open team captain (non-playing, unfortunately) said, "I don't understand it. The players all seemed in fine spirits. I did notice some of the players standing too close to the edge as I passed behind them, but I'm sure he wouldn't have felt anything".

Police identified the principal suspect (pictured), and are arranging an interview as we go to press.


