

There is a menu for the week, and each pack will contain a sandwich, piece of fruit and a drink. Each day, **before 9.30 am, you can**:


- choose your sandwich;

Bulletin Circulation Surges


The Editor and staff are pleased to report that circulation of the Bulletin reached an all-time high on Thursday, as shown below -
