2NT=15-18, stoppers; 2HS and 3C/D=good 6 card suit, 13-15
RCO style 2-s $\quad X=$ t/o, including $C$ $3 C=t / 0$, not including $C$

Other 2-s Lebensohl \& Western Cue over weak 2s; over 2NT (minors), 3C/D $=$ better HS; $\mathrm{X}=4 \mathrm{H}+4 \mathrm{~S}$ and 16+
