Over Strong 2 level bid: $\mathrm{X}=2$ suiter with $\mathrm{S} ; 2 \mathrm{NT}=2$ suiter without S Optimals: $X=$ TO of single suited option or 16+, all else natura 1D/HS= constructive; $1 N T=$ weak $D, 2 C=$ weak, nat 2D/HS as per opening bids; 2NT= strong 2 suiter
