The welcome package includes a list of the city's attractions. I hope you have time to enjoy some of them.

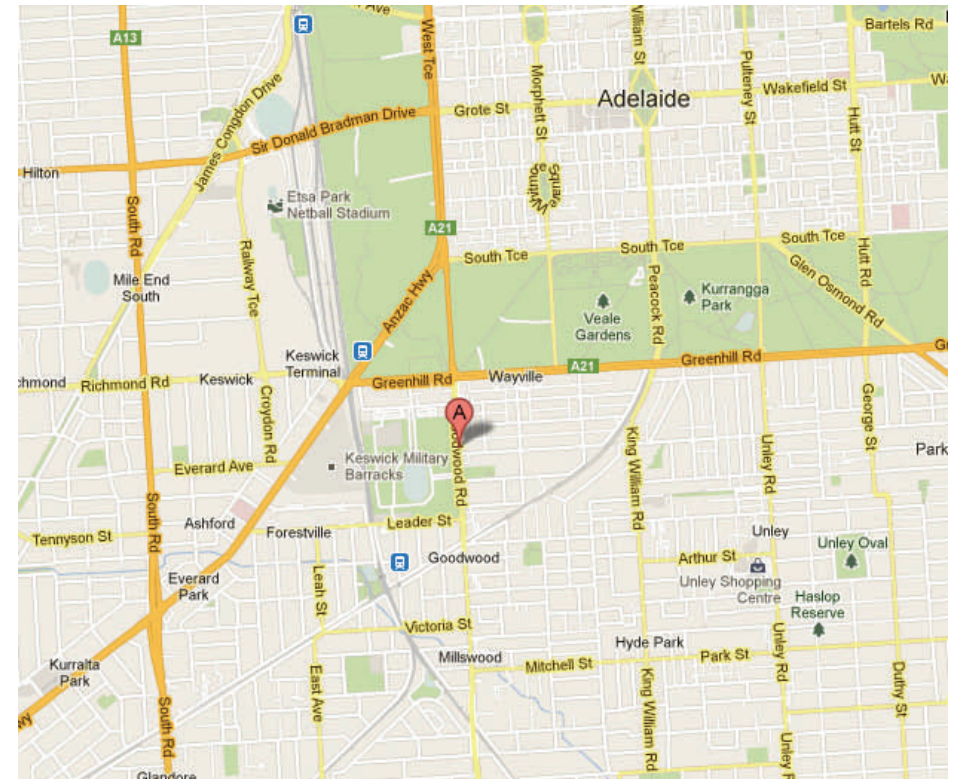

Adelaide Showground Information

Parking: There is ample free parking on Rose Terrace, off Goodwood Road. If anyone is mobility impaired however, please approach one of the Tournament Organisers for a closer alternative.

Catering: A tea/coffee station will be operating in the reception area of the Goyder Mezzanine. Specialist tea and coffee will be available for purchase from the on-site coffee shop, as will a variety of lunch and snack foods. The café is open from 9.30am to 4.00pm each day.

Score-up Facility: The venue hirers have made a score up area available for the teams competition. It will be located directly under the Goyder Mezzanine on the ground floor. We ask that this area is kept clean and tidy.

Smoking: There will be designated areas for smokers. Please ensure that you use the sand traps to butt out all cigarettes. There is no smoking inside the building.

Access to the Playing Area: Players may use the stairs to access the mezzanine playing floor. A lift is also available. The entrance to the lift is alongside the stairs to the playing area.

Toilets: There are ample toilet facilities on both the ground and first floor of the venue. They are clearly sign posted.

Public Transport: Goodwood Road services several different bus links into the City. Maps and timetables will be available from the hospitality desk at the venue.

Hospitality Desk: The desk will be manned by volunteers at times to suit the beginning and end of playing sessions. The Tournament Organiser will be available at the venue at all times however for emergency queries. Her telephone number is 0412 824 997.

At the end of play in the final stage of the Butler Pairs there will be farewell drinks and the presentation of trophies and medallions.

Format for the ANC

The first event will be the SABF Swiss Pairs, played on Saturday 6th July. The Interstate Teams will precede the Butler Pairs, beginning on Sunday 7th July and winding up with the finals, which finish on Friday 12th July. The only night play will be for the first stanza of the finals. This will be at 7.30 p.m. on Thursday 11th July.

The Butler Pairs will run from Saturday, 13th July to Thursday 18th July. The Open Butler will be played in 2 stages. The Women's Butler will held over 2 stages providing there are more than 30 pairs entered. Otherwise, the Women's Butler will be run as a single round robin alongside the Open Stage 1 and 2. The Seniors' Butler will be run as a Swiss and played in one stage only. There will be no night play — the final match each day begins at 4.30 p.m.

A Restricted Butler Pairs Event will be run alongside Stage 1 of the Open and Women's provided there are sufficient entries to do so.
