In the Juniors the WA opened 1C – but in the Seniors, a more cautions pass.

South has a tough decision – do you open 1S, 2S, 4S or Pass?

My advice: don't open a weak 2 with a void. Partner can't accurately assess the combined values.

My NSW Senior pair Mike Hughes and Kim Morrison did well to find the sacrifice – other room 7H for +17imps vs QLD.

Howard's End

Justin's 2H bid was limited, so he redoubled to show a maximum. I knew that we had half the high card points and six hearts, so decided to defend 2H redoubled. Luckily, we've discussed this so when I passed Nick knew that I wanted to defend. So he passed as well.

I led a high diamond, ducked to declarer's Queen and a diamond came back. Nick won and cashed the club Ace and King on which I played the 10 and 5. Nick exited a trump to the 10 and I ducked. Declarer won, played HA, HQ, club to dummy and a club. I ruffed and declared had two spade losers for one off.

But look what happens – if Nick plays a spade instead of heart I win the Ace, lead a second spade to the King and get a spade ruff. I give partner a club ruff and he leads a fourth spade. Declarer must ruff high. Now he can run the H10

but I duck and he plays a heart to the King. But now he is trapped in dummy and must lead a club so my HJ gets promoted.

That would be three off – for +1600, instead of one off for +400. Teammates were -110, so we could have gained 16 instead of 7imps.

Can we get it right? Maybe.

My C10 is count but I intended my C5 as a suit preference card. If he reads it as I intended it – he can work it out.

It's tough though. I passed the redouble so I'll normally have better hearts which doesn't leave much room for points in spades, given North's redouble. If North has SAJ – a spade lead's the only lead to let the contract make.

All in all – maybe we should just be happy with a 7 imp gain.

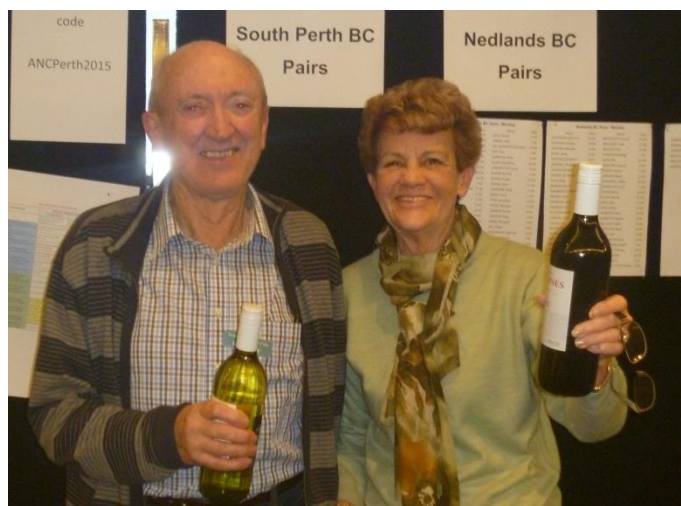

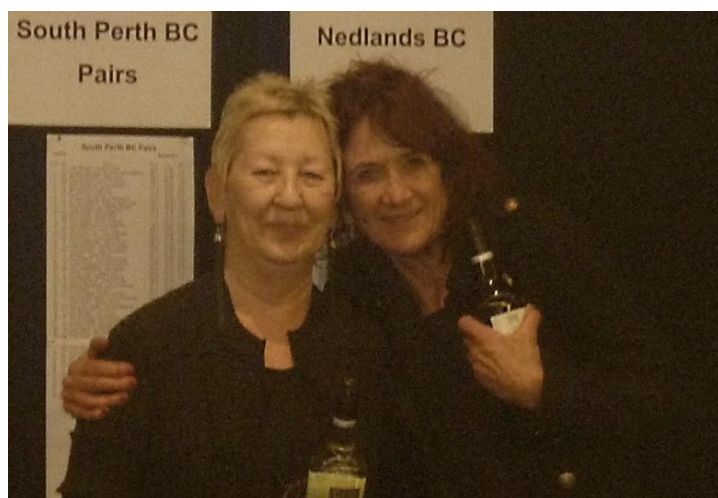
