Against 3-2 trump you will be able to survive a second diamond tap, so the key is how to handle 4-1 trumps.

One option is to play the Queen of Spades out of hand intending to pitch on the 3rd round of diamonds.

However West can counter by ducking, winning the 2nd round and locking declarer in dummy by continuing a 4th diamond after pitches on the 3rd round.

The winning line is to play low spade to the Ten at trick 3. West can no longer duck as if they do their trump trick will evaporate via two finesses.

Best is to play a 3rd round of diamonds, however, as before North can counter by pitching in hand and should West a 4th round of diamonds declarer can ruff in dummy and still has trump to get to hand to draw the outstanding trumps before running the clubs.

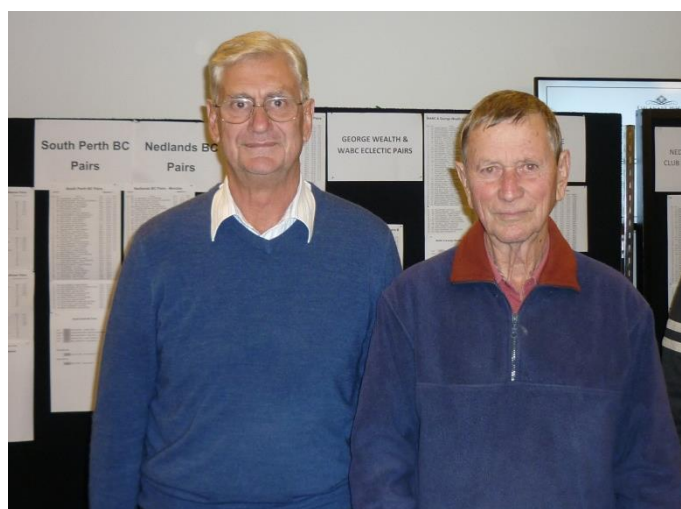

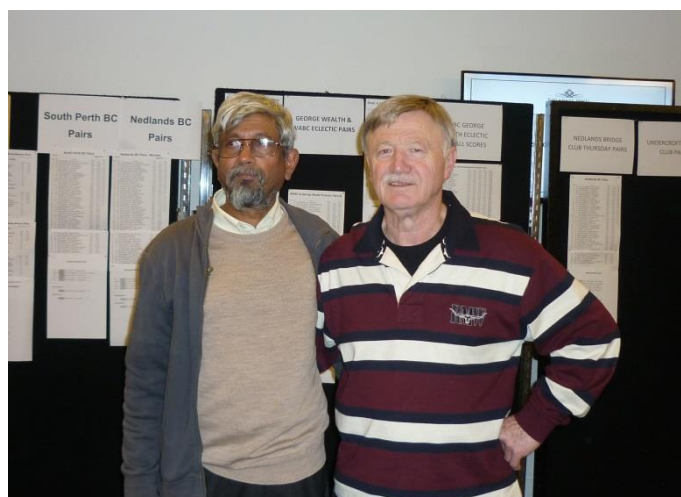

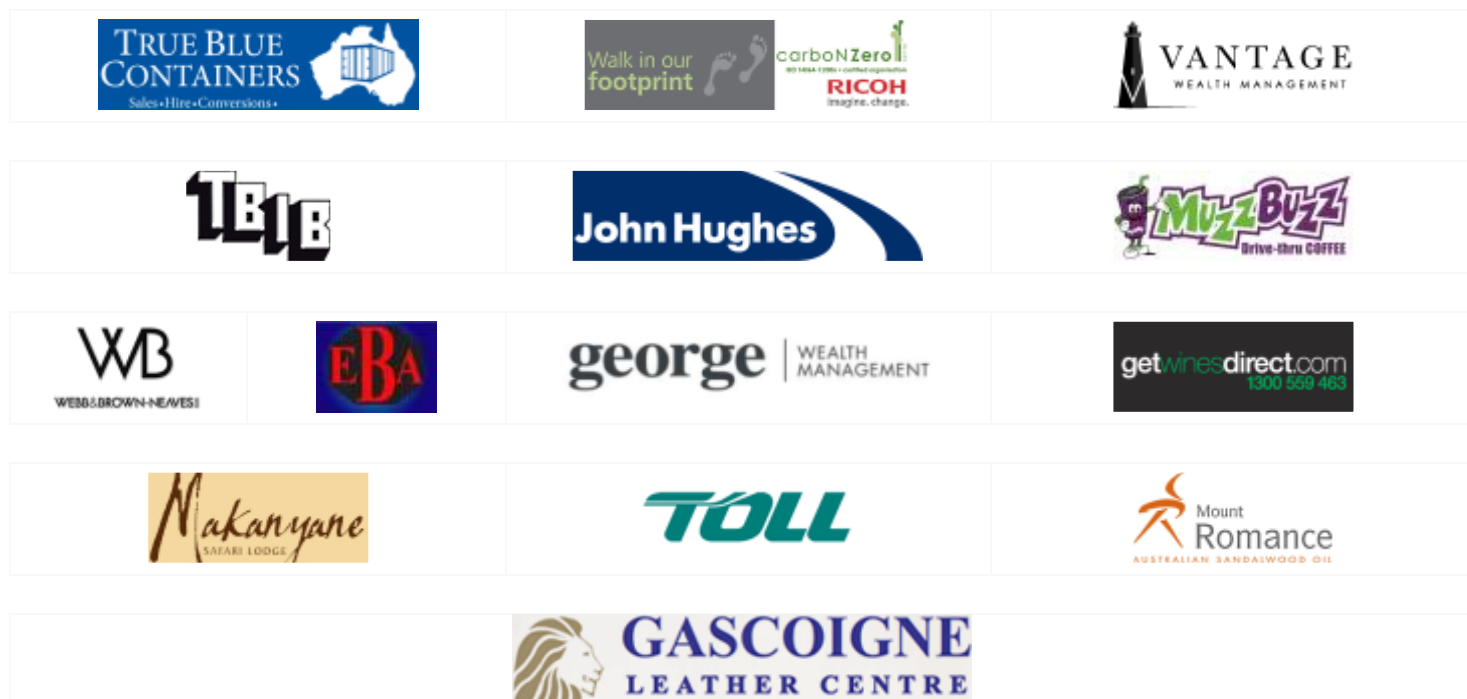
