


Cute Hands, with Uncle Tim

It bears repeating that our game is won not by committing brilliancies, but by avoiding blunders.

Firstly, two hands on a similar theme:

(Teams Finals Open - Set 3 Board 4)



Auction proceeds:


(1) Precision

On this board from set 3 of last week's Final , an accomplished declarer found himself at the helm in 4S E on the lead of the three top hearts, North following once, then, if his carding is to be believed, discarding D5 (encouraging) then C7 (odd count).

After due consideration, South continues D9.


Declarer won DA , cashed SA, shrugged, then continued with DK, and a diamond , ruffing with the 6. This was deservedly over-ruffed with S7, South continuing with H9 .North duly ruffed with SK and played a diamond back to promote the SJ for the third undertrick .

Had declarer won the first diamond, taken the club finesse, then played S to Ace and a spade up, he'd have made the same nine tricks made in the Closed Room and saved himself four IMPs (against 3S making for +140) in a desperately close match.



The next hand sees our previous North asleep at the helm in match 2 of the Butler Pairs.



North is in Four Spades on the lead of D4 to 5, 6 and J. Declarer crossed at trick 2 to HA, and led back through a lazy West to his HJ and the King.

East duly received his two diamond ruffs , but , if our culprit rises with HQ , would have made all three \ldots

Full hand:




On another theme, a hand from the next round of the Butler allowed West to compensate for his earlier carelessness .

Defend passively if side suit tricks cannot get away; defend aggressively if they can.

Plan the play on SK lead.


After winning SA at trick one , Declarer cashed HA, and was pleased to see both opponents follow .

I'd be interested in others' suggestions, but I believe that the best line for Declarer to ensure his contract is to cash CA, and continue with a second club.

As it happens, it continues CT - CJ - CQ . Declarer is now home, making even if South wins the club , can cash a spade bigger than the ten , and plays a heart - simply ducking , to set up two entries to set up the clubs .

No other exit hurts.


Full hand:

Pretend Double Squeeze

In the Butler we faced seasoned campaigners Bruce Neill and Simon Hinge, and partner Sue Gammon opened 2C as West. I was close to positive 2S response but downgraded to 2D. Sue bid 3NT (24-25) and I blasted unscientifically 6S.

Simon (South) led to a club which I won, followed by the AQ of spades, and then for fun I tried for 13 tricks, muttering to the opponents that I was only looking for the overtrick.

I cashed a club, ruffed a club so LHO was the only one guarding clubs. Then I ran off spades, throwing dummy's hearts. Bruce was unable to keep the heart and the diamond guard, and he chose to ditch the ace then queen of hearts, making my jack good for the overtrick.

OK, not a true double squeeze – just a simple squeeze against whoever had the long diamonds.
