

Morphettville Information

Parking: There is ample free parking with access from Anzac Highway (Junction Car Park - marked C2 on the map). If anyone is mobility impaired, please approach the Tournament Organiser for an alternative.

Catering: Tea/coffee and lunch items will be available for purchase from the catering window in the playing area from 8.30am each day.

Score-up Facility: Tables have been set aside for score up for all State Team participants. These tables will be located along the windows.

Smoking: There will be designated area for smokers. Please ensure that you use the sand traps to butt out all cigarettes. There is no smoking inside the building.

Access to the Playing Area: Players may use the stairs to access the playing area. A lift is located adjacent to the stairs.

Toilets: There are ample toilet facilities on the second floor of the building. They are clearly signed.

Public Transport: Morphett Road is a designated tram stop between Adelaide and Glenelg. Morphettville Racecourse tram stop is only available on race days. Numerous buses also stop outside the venue. Maps & timetables will be available from the hospitality desk at the venue.

Hospitality Desk: The desk will be manned by volunteers at times to suit the beginning of play for the Interstate Teams, Butler and Congress events.

Taxis: Numbers for local taxis are: Suburban - 131008 and Adelaide Independent - 132211.

Bar Facility: The Bar will be open after play and until 7.00pm each day.

Venue Closure: The Derby Pavilion will close at 7.30pm each day.

Format for Championship Events

The first event of the Championships will be the Paul Lavings' Bridge Gear Welcome Swiss Pairs, played on Saturday 11th July.

The Interstate Teams will precede the Butler Pairs, beginning on Sunday 12th July and winding up with the finals, which finish on Thursday 16th July. The only event to be played at night will be the first stanza of the Interstate Teams Final, which will commence at 5.00pm on Wednesday 15th July.

The ANC Matchpoint Interstate Swiss Pairs will commence on Thursday 16th July and will be played as a single field Matchpoint Swiss Pairs event, played over 10 x 10 board matches—5 on Thursday 16th and 5 on Friday 17th July. Prizes will be awarded to the highest placed Open, Women's, Senior and Youth Pairs.

The TBIB Butler Pairs will run from Saturday 18th to Thursday 23rd July. The TBIB Open, Women's and Seniors' Butler Pairs will be conducted in two stages—a Preliminary Stage and a Final Stage. The format for these events can be found on the website under Supplementary Regulations:

The TBIB Restricted Butler Pairs Event will be run alongside Stage 1 of the TBIB Open Butler and will consist of 9 x 12 board matches in a Swiss movement.

Eligibility: Restricted Butler – under 300 Masterpoints as at 31/12/2019; Senior Butler – must be born before 1/01/1960; Youth – Must be born on or after 1/01/1995; Restricted Section of Welcome Swiss Pairs – under 300 Masterpoints as at 31/03/2020.

Youth Discount: 50% off all entry fees – DOB must be advised when entering – all T&Cs apply.

Payment for entry into Stage 2 of the Open, Women's or Senior Butler Pairs can be made on site using the credit card facility available. Stage 2 Open will be \$480/pair, Women \$240/pair and Seniors \$240/pair.

Payment for the ANC Swiss Pairs A and B may be made using this facility. The cost for each of these events will be \$180/pair.
