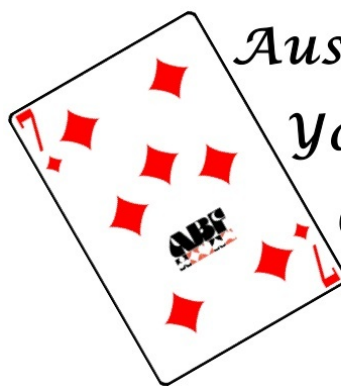

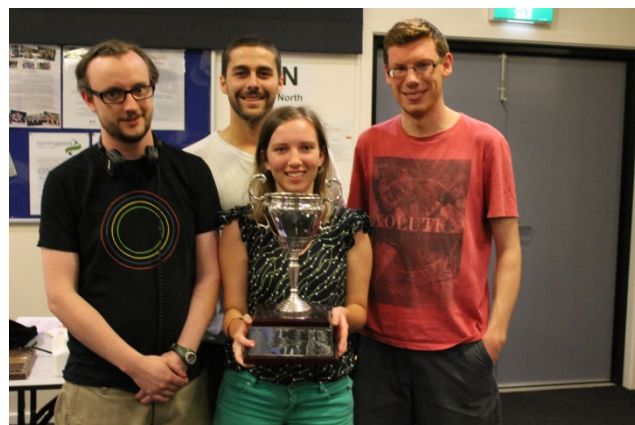

Board 10 from the Crazy Pairs produced the following auction to 6♦:

The instructions for the board were not to be opened until after the bidding was complete. Knowing this, East very reasonably doubled in anticipation of the craziness, and Grace as North fearlessly redoubled!

The instructions were then opened and it stated that after the sixth trick (of normal play), North and East must switch their hands and continue the play. West led a heart and dummy tracked with:

Dlr: W

Vul: All

♠ AK6542

♥ -

♦ AK10

♣ AK109



Contract: 6♦XX/S

Lead: ♥5

♠ 3

♥ 632

♦ Q875432

♣ J5

The play was straightforward. The Heart lead was ruffed in dummy with the ♦A, the ♦K was cashed, then ♠AK (discarding a Heart), then ♣AK, with everyone following suit. The dummy was now swapped with East's hand, leaving this position:

13 tricks were made for the crazy score of +2230! Even if the ♥A was played at trick 1, 6♦ is still unbeatable. Good redouble Grace!

Over West's 1♣ opening, North started with a lurking pre-emptive overcall. When the bidding came back around to North the first golden rule of bidding was broken bent: **"Don't pre-empt and then bid again"**.

After East-West competed up to 4♣, South felt obliged to show the support that had been undisclosed on the previous round.

Once East-West arrived in 5♣, South now thought the auction was high enough, and Doubled for penalties.

North now simultaneously bent two more rules of bidding: **"Don't pull your partner's Penalty Doubles."** and **"Don't bid 5-over-5"**.

These golden rules can't be worth very much, since three were broken on the one deal, and North-South made 5♦X with an overtrick!

North-South scored +950 and gained 28 cross-IMPs on the deal

The curious defence to hold the contract to only 11 tricks, is for East to lead the unsupported ♠A (West dropping the singleton ♠K) and then a second round of Spades which West needs to ruff with the singleton ♦Q.

Q: Would you rather live in the land of Hogwarts and be a muggle, or live in a pokemon world where you could only catch Magikarp?

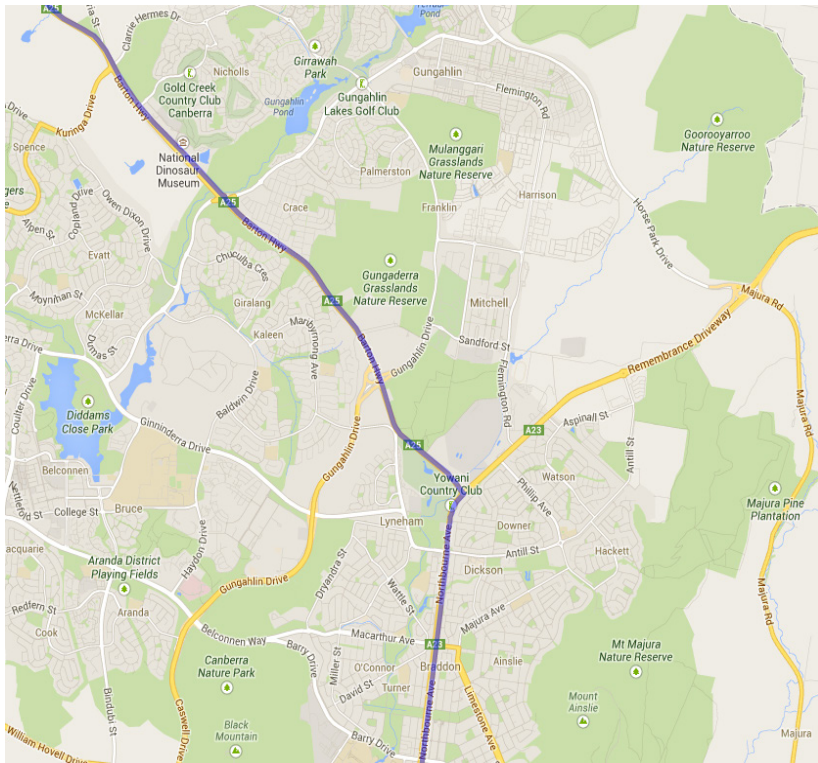
I'd much rather the pokemon world because at least there's pokemon.

I think we have 8.

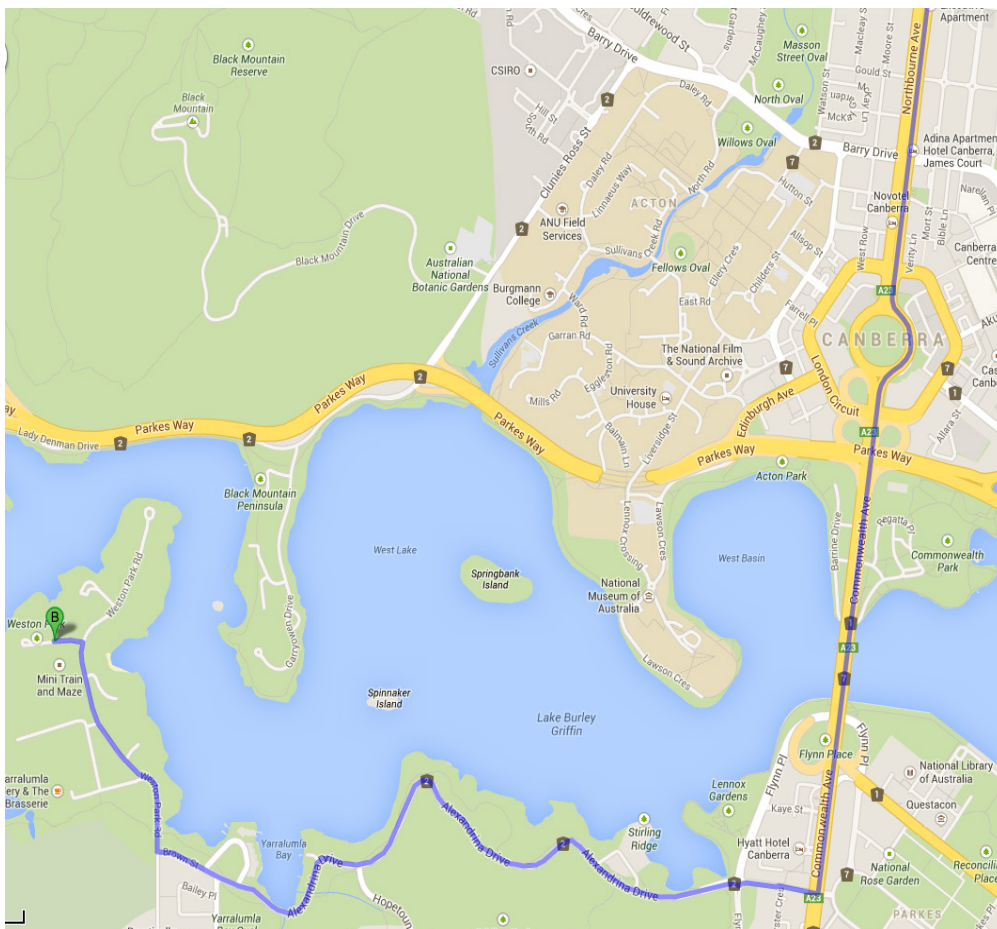
End of Youth Week BBQ – Weston Park
