Open Pairs: Two qualifying and three final sessions Sunday Feb 22nd to Tuesday Feb 24th. ABF playoff points.

Open Teams: Six sessions (12 matches) commencing Tuesday evening Feb 24th and concluding Friday 27th at 5 p.m. ABF playoff points.

The above events will be conducted at the ANA Hotel.

Restricted Pairs: Five sessions in parallel with the Open Pairs.

**Restricted Teams:** Six sessions in parallel with the Open Teams.

Seniors Pairs: Five sessions in parallel with the Open pairs. Attracts ABF playoff points.

Seniors Teams: Six sessions in parallel with the Open Teams. Attracts ABF playoff points.

All restricted and seniors events will be conducted at the Gold Coast International Hotel (GCI), which is 300 metres from the ANA Hotel. Seniors events will be open to players who have attained the age of 55 prior to the start of the specific event. Restricted events (both pairs and teams) will be open to players who have not attained Life Master status as at September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2003. There will be special prizes in the pairs for players with less than 150 masterpoints.

- 3. Welcome Walk-in Pairs: \$20 per pair. Pay at table.
- 4. Wednesday Walk-in Pairs: \$20 per pair. Pay at table.
- 5. ANA Shield: Free to congress participants. Otherwise \$20 per pair.
- 6. Congress Dinner / Dance: Complimentary to those who have played in both pairs and teams events. For those playing in only one event: \$30. For non-participants: \$60. But, because numbers are limited, attendance MUST be arranged through the functions desk no later than 8 p.m. Wednesday. Even then, tickets will be issued sequentially according to the time the arrangement was finalized. 'First in, best dressed'. Entry is by ticket only and tickets are non-transferrable.

#### GENERAL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Entries must be made using an entry form and accompanied by full payment of fees (unless the Convenor or Entries Coordinator specifically authorises later payment). Note the conditions in the entry form regarding entries without payment.
- 2. The QBA reserves the right to reject entries at its absolute discretion and without assigning a reason. Any rejected entry will be returned as promptly as possible and money refunded. No correspondence or debate will be entered into.
- 3. A minimum of neat casual dress must be observed at all times in the playing area.
- 4. No smoking will be permitted in the defined playing area.
- 5. Entries are open only to ABF registered players and bona fide overseas contestants.
- 6. The ABF System and Alerting Regulations (as current at 31.12.2003) will apply. Players are responsible for ensuring the accuracy of their system classification. If in doubt, submit your system in advance to the Chief Tournament Director. Copies of these regulations will be posted at the venue, as will supplementary regulations. They will also be published on the QBA and ABF websites at least a week prior to the event.
- 7. Masterpoint awards: Gold in main events, red in walk-ins. Seniors events awards at 75% of Open awards. Restricted events at 47.5% of Open. Substantial awards for outright places (top half of field in pairs, top third of field in teams).

#### SUMMARY OF SYSTEMS REGULATIONS

Open Pairs: GREEN, BLUE and RED systems permitted.

Seniors Pairs: GREEN, BLUE and RED systems permitted.

Restricted Pairs: GREEN and BLUE systems only.

Open Teams: All systems permitted except that YELLOW systems will not be permitted in the first two matches of the Swiss and thereafter will be limited to the top quarter of the field. Any pair proposing to play a YELLOW system must lodge two copies of their system with the Chief Tournament Director prior to the commencement of the teams events.

Seniors Teams: As for Open Teams

Restricted Teams: GREEN, BLUE and RED systems permitted.

**Protected Pairs:** Certain pairs may apply for Protected Pair status. This will apply in this tournament only in the Open and Seniors Pairs.

#### Requirements:

- 1. The pair must be playing a GREEN system.
- 2. Both players must be below the status of National Master OR one player must be below the status of Local Master.
- 3. The pair must apply in advance to the Chief Tournament Director for Protected Pair status. If this is approved they must apply both a GREEN sticker and a BROWN sticker on their system cards. Protected pairs should ascertain at the start of a round whether their opponents are playing a red system in order to claim their protected pair status.
