ENTRIES.

All entries should be in by now so PLEASE check on the website & ensure your names are registered in the correct events. It is only the Ivy Dahler Swiss Pairs that can be entered the day before. If you find you are not entered or have just realised you wish to play please contact us ASAP as entries can still be taken at the discretion of the QBA

PARKING

Sorry but the Convention Centre is not budging & there will be a charge for parking. There will be a weekly pass issued from Saturday 17/02/07 to Saturday 24/02/07 for \$20.00 (8 days) or a flat rate of \$5.00 per day. I understand you will pay on arrival at the car park.

BUS

We will now be running 2 buses & will incorporate a run up to Surfers. We will have the bus routes worked out & a better understanding of the timetables later in the week. SURVEY

We have been granted funding for the 2008 GC from the Qld Regional Tourist Board but one of the requisites is that we need to supply certain facts & figures re our players. It is completely confidential – no name phone number or email is asked for. I BEG of you to fill them in & bring them back (to the registration desk) .It is very important to us to get a complete picture. So that means we need YOURS! SATCHELS

Everyone will be supplied with a satchel which can be collected from the Registration desk at the Convention Centre. Each satchel will have a label showing where you will be seated for the first session of the pairs. (Eg Table Open 10 NS). It will contain useful information, various vouchers & your pen which we expect you to take with you when you go to play.

OPEN EVENTS

Everything will be colour co-ordinated in shades of blue including tablecloths & table numbers. There should be blue balloons indicating the general area in the room you will be sitting & blue balloons in the corridors showing you where your results will be displayed.

SENIORS

Everything will be colour co-ordinated in shades of red/pink /lavender with pink & lavender tablecloths & red table numbers, There will be balloons in shades of red indicating the general area in the room you will be sitting (towards the Casino side of the playing area) & more balloons showing you where your results will be displayed (in the corridor facing the walkway to the Casino)

RESTRICTED

Everything will be colour co-ordinated in shades of green including tablecloths & table numbers. There will be green balloons indicating the general area of the room you will be playing (to the right as you face the playing area). There will be green balloons in the corridor to show where your results will be displayed (again to the right of the registration desk)

HELP for RESTRICTED

From 12.30pm on Sunday 18/02/07 (a half hour before play starts) there will be help available You can go to the playing area & people will be available to answer any questions you might have, check your system card is filled out correctly & ensure you know the procedures.

BAR

The bar in the Convention Centre will be open half an hour before play starts & will remain open until 11.30pm each night. At least this is how it will start out but it will be the old **"USE IT OR LOSE IT**" philosophy. A full review of the other drinking spots in the area will be in the first bulletin. The bar will be open at 6pm on Saturday night for the Welcome Pairs.

SMORGASBOARD

On Tuesday night The Convention Centre will be putting on a smorgasbord with seafood for \$45.00 per head. All those wishing to attend please let our Registration desk know as Gerald will be looking after the tickets. Jupiters offer as an alternative a buffet dinner with an Asian theme in their Food Fantasy restaurant. The bridge player's special (in 5.30 pm & out by 6.30pm) is \$23.60 plus a complimentary glass

of house wine or beer. You must produce your score book or a hand record as evidence you are a bridge player. You will need to book through 1800074144.

CHINESE NEW YEAR

I understand Chinese New Year is Tuesday 20/02/07 - this has put a strain on accommodation requirements but luckily there is so much available there was never a problem (all 580 beds in Jupiter's were booked out by the week after Christmas).
