

We reached a silly 6D contract and I was faced with holding my trump losers to one with the following suit:

Dummy 8 6 5 2

Declarer K 10 9 7 4

Im had mentally decided that my only chance was Ace doubleton on side so, when I led a small card from dummy, I took little notice when East hesitated noticeably before playing the Jack.

Up went the King to West's singleton Ace and down went the contract!

This was stupid! Would East have hesitated with AJ tight and would she play the Jack from AJ x?

The only explanation was that East had begun with QJx and had mistakenly decided to cover.

It is because they are able to pick up these nuances that experts have it over us mere mortals.

At the other table Nigel Rosendorff opened the North cards 1D and thereafter the auction was the same through to 3NTx.

Whenthis came to Andy (South), he found 5D for +600

AND roman spent some time in thought. 5H showed 2 keycards. Roman believed that LHO was 5-5 in the minors, rather than 5-6 or better since he hadn't bid 2NT on the first round. Finally, he bid 7NT.

The King of clubs was led and Roman took this to play 4 rounds of spades, learning that East had a singleton. Roman then pictured East's hand as 1-2-5-5 and so plays for the Queen of hearts to drop.

## APP(E)AL(L)ING WISDOM

First some definitions:

Inclination of committee (WBF Code of Practice) The expectation is that each appeal committee presumes initially that the Director's ruling is correct. The ruling is overturned only on the basis of evidence presented.

A "<u>logical alternative</u>" (WBF Code of Practice) is a different action that, amongst the class of players in question and using the methods of the partnership, would be given serious consideration by a significant proportion of such players, of whom it is reasonable to think some might adopt it.





Inadvertency. (Law # 25A) "Until his partner makes a call, a player may substitute his call for an inadvertent call but only if he does so, or attempts to do so, without pause for thought."

There were no alerts. South had no possibility of describing the 6-5 as all 2-suited options were constructive. South asserted that she would have bid 4S over 2D had she been aware that the opponents were using "inverted minors". Director rule score stands and NS appealed.

The AC agreed that this particular South may have bid 4S but determined that it was not an action that would be given serious consideration by a significant proportion of experienced players in the field.

EW used a YELLOW system in which Pass showed an opening hand, 1C showed 6-10, any distribution and 2H described 2 major suits. All the relevant calls were made in tempo and alerted. NS did not ask for any clarification until the conclusion of the auction. South asserted that he did not double in case 4S was a better contract. The declarer ruled that the table score stand as he could find no reason to believe that East had received unauthorised information but had risked preferring H to S. The AC agreed with the director's statement that no transfer of unauthorized information could be proven. The director's decision was upheld; no adjustment. The AC advised the respondents that they had a responsibility to bid correctly when playing a YELLOW system else the "Rule of Co-incidence" might apply.

The director accepted that West intended to remove his alert card and his display of the "Pass" card was inadvertent. The bidding reverted to West and continued to 4H. Although the facts were not crystal clear, the AC ruled that there was not sufficient evidence to alter the decision of the director.


Although the 2D was intended to show H/C the correct systemic agreement given during the auction was that it showed S/H. The Director ruled that N had received unauthorized information concerning his misbid and "Pass" was a logical alternative to 5C. The AC determined that whether or not North recognized his misbid before the explanation was irrelevant and upheld the director's decision. The AC determined that the appeal was without merit and applied a penalty of 2 VP.

Four boards later and Ash was at it again



Mike and Ash's teammate, English international, Brian Callaghan, did not enjoy his partner's choice of defensive exit in the same round




Val Gardiner opened 1D as dealer and Brian replied 1H. South intervened with 1S and Val rebid a no trump. North shot the spade game.

The Ace of hearts was led and then came a switch to the Jack of diamonds. South cashed the Ace of trumps and then played a small spade which Val took with the King. She continued diamonds to the Ace and declarer drew the last trump with dummy's Queen. He cashed the Queen of diamonds and played a club to his Queen and Val's King to leave this position:

Val played the 10 of diamonds and Brian was fixed.

If he discards a heart then declarer ruffs a heart on table, cashes the Ace of clubs and ruffs a club to get back to the now established heart trick.

Alternatively, if Brian discards a club, then declarer plays a club to the Ace, ruffs a club and returns to dummy by ruffing a heart to enjoy the club trick.





North redoubled and it was at this point that Michael noticed that North's first bid was red not green.
