## **RESTRICTED EVENTS**

## Wednesday 9 January to Friday 11 January PIANOLA NON-LIFE MASTERS TEAMS

Starts: 10am Wednesday, 6 sessions, 8 x 20 board Swiss matches, Finishes 4pm, Friday. Entry fee \$580 per team of four, five or six players. Each ABF player must have 300MPs or less as at 30/9/2018 and Grand Slam players must have a rating under 56%

2 Category Prizes: All members of a team must be Restricted (U300) or Novice (U100). Prizes and medals. Pairs containing eligible Grand Slam pairs will only be considered for the Restricted category prize.

This is a great event for those pairs who prefer long format teams matches. Assistance can be given if you don't have team mates because we will find you another friendly pair of your standard to play with. Just enter as a pair online or through the downloadable paper entry form.

## If you prefer to play pairs: why not try:

### Wednesday 9 January PENLINE ONE DAY PAIRS

Starts: 10am, 2 sessions, 6 x 8 board Swiss matches, Finishes 5pm. Entry fee \$120 per pair. 2 prize categories Open and Restricted (U300).

This Swiss style event allows Restricted Pairs to improve their bridge by playing against a mix of better players and restricted players of their own standard.

## Thursday – Friday 10-11 January CHRIS DIMENT MATCHPOINT SWISS PAIRS

Starts: 10am, Thursday, 4 sessions, 7 x 14 board matches. Entry fee \$250 per pair. Finishes 5.30pm Friday. 2 prize categories Open and Restricted (U300).

Named after well-liked Festival Tournament Director, Chris Diment, this Swiss style event with longer matches and matchpoint scoring offers Restricted Pairs the opportunity to improve their bridge by playing against a mix of better players and restricted players of their own standard.

## Saturday – Sunday 12-13 January PENLINE 500 SWISS PAIRS CHAMPIONSHIP

Session times both days 10.00am and 2.30pm. 11 x 9 board matches. Entry Fee \$250 per pair. Finishes 5.00pm Sunday. Each ABF player must have 500MPs or less as at 30/9/2018 and Grand Slam players must have a rating under 56%.

A popular Swiss event with shorter matches and Butler (average) style scoring. An excellent way to enjoy friendly competition with teams style scoring.

Note: Restricted Pairs and Teams that wish to play against more experienced players in a higher category event should consider the **Red Plum Life Masters Teams** is a three-day teams event for under Grand master level players commencing on Wednesday 9 January and finishing on Friday 11 January. Or, the **Canberra Rex U750 and U300 Teams** on the three days from Monday 14 January to Wednesday 16 January.
