

SUMMER FESTIVAL OF BRIDGE: WHAT TO DO IF THE CAR PARKING AT THE REX HOTEL AND FENNER HALL IS FULL

If this is on the weekend of 12-13th January.....

The good news is that there is a lot of **unrestricted free street parking** in a lot of the streets around the Rex Hotel area including the immediate streets adjacent to the Hotel and Fenner Hall on the eastern side of Northbourne especially Henty, Ijong, Lowanna and Dooring streets.

If you are looking to park, Monday to Fridays then:

- you can try the two 4 hours car parking lots on Girrahween Street south of the Rex – they charge \$8-9 for four hours but you will need to move your car after the first match if you are playing the teams. This is a 6-8 minute walk to the Rex across Haig Park or via Northbourne Ave
- you can drive over to the large free car park at the Ainslie Football Club on Wakefield Avenue. Then there is a mostly flat 14-15 minute walk back to Rex via Limestone Avenue, Lowanna and Ipima Streets. Depending on demand for this parking area, the Festival Organisers may consider using shuttle buses to take players back to the car park. If we do, further details will be published in the Daily Bulletin or you can inquire at the Festival Help Desk.
