1♣	Strong Club <b>OR</b> 3+ Suit AND 11 HCPs	May very occasionally be done on fewer HCP with either a longer suit or third in hand
1♦	Natural 3+ AND 11 HCPs	Ditto
1♥	Natural 4+ AND 11 HCPs	Ditto
1♠	Natural 4+ AND 11 HCPs	Ditto
1NT	Any Balanced Hand fully contained within an 11 to 18 HCP range.	May contain a 5-card major or 6-card minor but this is not part of systemic expectation
2♣	Acol OR Strong <b>AND/OR</b> Natural 11-15 with or without Major	Covers all hands too strong to open at the 1-level & are not covered by the 2♦ & 2NT openings
2♦	Acol <b>AND/OR</b> Strong <b>AND/OR</b> Natural 11-15 with or without Major <b>AND/OR</b> A Weak Two Bid in ♦'s or in a major <b>AND/OR</b> 5+/5+ Colour/Rank/Odd.	Weak 2 in a major or 23-24 balanced

	<b>Canapé Transfers over opponents' 1NT opening:</b> 2♣ = Transfer to diamonds initially but may be both majors (normally 54) or, infrequently, both minors (55) or canapé (4♦s and & 6+ outside suit good hand in terms of playing tricks)  2♦ = Transfer to hearts or, infrequently, both reds (55) or canapé (4♥s and & 6+ outside suit good hand in terms of playing tricks)  2♥ = Transfer to spades or, infrequently, both majors (55) or canapé (4♠s and & 6+ outside suit good hand in terms of playing tricks)  2♠ = Transfer to clubs or, infrequently, canapé (4♥s and & 6+ outside suit good hand in terms of playing tricks)  2NT = 5/5 ♠ & ♣  3♣ = 5/5 ♥ & ♣  3♦ = 5/5 ♠ & ♦
