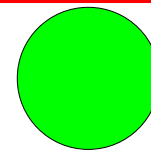

Exclusion Blackwood

Canape Transfers over opponents' 1NT: 2♣= or both M (54) or both m (55);

2♦ = 5+♥ or 5♥=5♦ or 4♥=6 other good hand; 2♥ = 5+♠ or 5♠=5♥ or 4♠=6 other good hand;

2♠ = 55 ♠+♣; 2NT = ♣♠; 3♣ = 55 ♣+♥; 3♦ = 55 ♦+♠
