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## OTHER NOTES

Change of suit forcing except over 1 NT rebid. Exclusion $\mathrm{B} /$ wood in oppositions suit only.
Blackout after reverse ( cheapest of 4th suit or 2 NT weakest)
Transfers over NT interpose ( whatever the level), except is Stayman
Over our rebid showing 21-22 bal: 3t is Stayman ( 4 card)
2D-2H-2S shows 5 card minor,21-22 and then 3 by responder asks which one
