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

10. OTHER NOTES

scramblesohl : after X of 2M (or equivalent) 2NT requests better minor. If 2NT bidder removes to a suit below the doubled suit, that is weak. 2NT then 3NT shows both OM and stopper, 2NT then cue bid show OM but no stopper. Immediate cue bid denies 4OM and denies stopper.

Same after natural interference over our 1NT
