VENUE

DERBY ROOM, AJC FUNCTION CENTRE RANDWICK RACECOURSE

Car and pedestrian access is via Gate 1, Alison Road, Randwick. If traffic is too heavy to effect a safe right turn please follow the route on the map below which allows you to do a U-turn at the roundabout at Centennial Park gates.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Buses to Randwick Racecourse depart from Central Station (Eddy Avenue) and from Circular Quay, consult 131500.com.au for details.

PARKING

Free parking is available at the venue. Please comply with the instructions of the parking attendant.

CATERING

A free self serve tea and coffee facility will be available in the playing area. In addition Argy's Café will be open to allow purchase of refreshments and will provide a facility for ordering lunch.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Persons applying to enter the Sydney Spring Nationals should be aware of the following:

- 1. The Regulating Authority (The Australian Bridge Federation) reserves the right to refuse admission to any player who is not in good standing with any registered bridge club, bridge association or the Regulating Authority.
- No entry will be regarded as complete unless an entry form has been submitted before the closing date, Friday 15 October 2010, with full entry fees paid and ABF numbers supplied. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser.
- 3. All players resident in Australia must be current financial members of the ABF Masterpoint Scheme.
- 4. Players born on or after 1/1/1984 receive a 50% rebate on their entry fees to all events at the Sydney Spring Nationals.
- 5. All session times in this brochure are provisional and may be altered by the organisers as necessary to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the responsibility of players to be aware of the starting times of the sessions and rounds as announced by the Director and posted on the notice board.
- 6. Mobile phones and other means of electronic communication must be switched off whilst in the playing area. Penalties will apply for non-compliance (see ABF Tournament Regulations, Section 19.1).

REGULATIONS

The System and Alerting Regulations for ABF Events apply to the Sydney Spring Nationals and can be found on the <u>ABF Website</u>.

Supplementary regulations for the Sydney Spring Nationals will be posted on the ABF Website.

All systems and conventions, including those categorised as YELLOW, are permitted in the Open and Womens Teams, subject to the detailed regulations found in the current ABF Tournament Regulations. YELLOW systems are not permitted in any other event. Only GREEN and BLUE systems are permitted in the Restricted Teams, and in addition, no BROWN sticker conventions can be used. Further details for YELLOW systems can be found in the ABF Tournament regulations. Pairs in any doubt about the classification of their system should submit a concise summary to the Tournament Organiser.

PLAYOFF QUALIFYING POINTS

PQPs are awarded according to ABF regulations to players who are eligible. Detailed information about PQPs and entry to the Australian Team Playoff is published only on the ABF website.

Linda Stern 1949-2007

Linda was born in London in 1949. The family migrated to New Zealand in 1957 settling in Auckland. After finishing school Linda completed her Diploma of Education, travelled to Europe, taught in London and then settled in Australia. She met David in 1975 and they married in 1979. Soon after, their son Justin was born followed three years later by their daughter Danielle.

Linda enjoyed considerable success as a leading Australian bridge player in state, national and international events including:

- representing
 - NSW nine times in Womens Teams at the Interstate Championships between 1978 and 2003 (notching up three wins).
 - Australia in the 2005 Pacific Asia Womens Teams Championship
 - > Australia as captain of the Womens team in 2002 in Bangkok
- winning
 - > the Interstate Womens Pairs in 1981 and 1984 with her mother-in-law Gerda
 - the National Womens Teams in 1986
 - > the NSW Womens Pairs in 1993 with her mother-in-law Gerda
 - the Spring National Womens Teams in 2002
 - the National Open Teams in 2007 partnered by Peter Gill with teammates David Stern - Robert Grynberg and Boye Brogeland - Espen Erichsen after finishing second the previous year.

Linda was the proprietor of the Double Bay Bridge Centre between 1994 and her untimely death in 2007. Linda is best remembered for her warm and sunny disposition, cheerfulness and friendliness.
