The Spring Nationals eBulletin

This year sees the introduction of an electronic Bulletin. We invite contributions from any player who finds a hand of interest for whatever reason. Our Esteemed eBulletin Editors are David Beauchamp & Louis Koolen.



I know that some of the participants in the Spring Nationals are well published bridge writers, e.g. Ron

Klinger. Some are occasional bridge writers, e.g. Rakesh Kumar, while some have never written an article, but may well be latent authors. Contributions from everyone are welcome.

The features of the eBulletin are:

- 1. Access will be via the Spring Nationals Website through eBulletins
- 2. Publication is on an article by article basis.
- 3. Writing up an article is easy.

- (a) obtain a user name and password from the eBulletin Help Desk, or email john@scudder.id.au
- (b) go to the <u>eBulletins</u>, login and consult the menu on the right
- (c) start your article by selecting add new from the menu
- (d) to view a simple example of a completed template and its outcome, click on <u>eBulletins for Dummies</u> in the menu on the right
- (e) for a more detailed information, click help
- (f) use the **pulldowns** at the bottom of the template to define the Event, Round and Board Number. The code for that hand will be shown, which you **copy and paste** into your article at the point at which it is to appear in the text created in (g), using the +↓ button on the Toolbar. The hand layout will be error free. You can include bidding or more than one hand if appropriate
- (g) put a title, author and synopsis in the appropriate fields and then use the text box to describe the interesting details of the hand and if you wish, the name(s) of the players/perpetrators involved.
- (h) use the **Preview** button to see your article, close this window, amend your article as necessary until you are happy with the result. Then click **Update**
- polish your article, Update again if necessary then click Submit. This will send the article to our Esteemed Editors, who have the discretion to modify your article a little
- 4. The Esteemed Editors will publish your finished article on the eBulletin page. All articles remain on view throughout the Spring Nationals with the most recent at the top of the list.
- 5. If you are not computer literate, your article on paper can be submitted for you by someone at the reception desk.
- 6. No trees will be sacrificed for the eBulletin there will be no paper version

Transport

Comfort Inn Patrons

Announcements at the Spring Nationals

As of August 1st 2013 there will be a significant change to the current alerting procedures which will have an impact on all players.

When you open $1 \pm$ or a natural 1NT, there will be no need to alert the bid. Instead opener's partner must automatically "announce", without waiting to be asked, the essential meaning of the bid.

For a natural 1NT opening, this announcement is the strength range. So partner says: "15 to 17" or "12 to 14" or whatever the range is.

For a 1♣ opening, it depends on the system. For natural systems, partner announces the minimum club length guaranteed, saying "4 plus clubs" or "3 plus clubs", etc.

For strong club systems, you announce the point range. In Precision you would say "strong at least 16 points".

For other systems, for example Polish Club, which has multiple means for the 1. opening, partner simply announces "unusual".

After any announcement, the opponents will still be able to ask supplementary questions, however the basic information already conveyed will avoid much of that need. A side benefit of this new approach is that many of the problems currently created due to inopportune (and sometimes pointed) enquiries will now disappear. And opponents will no longer be at risk of confusion caused by variable 1NT ranges and the like.

Penalties for Inaccurate or Missing Scores

Players must record the score on their Bridgemate for each board after it is played and before the commencement of the next board.

It is an offence to leave the table at the conclusion of a match without first confirming the completeness and validity of the data entered into the scoring unit. Every player present at the table is equally responsible for the accuracy of the scores. Offences will incur penalties.
