

Accommodation

The principal hotel from last year, the **Comfort Inn & Suites** at Burwood Heights (go to www.comfortburwood.com.au for more information), have kept the same rates as last year for bridge players. The hotel is located about 4 km from the venue.

In the city

If staying in the CBD is more to your liking then the train from Museum Station to Canterbury Station takes 25 minutes and runs every 15 minutes. It is a pleasant 15-20 minute walk (about 1 km) from the station to the venue. Alternatively you can take the train to the next stop, Campsie, and catch the 413 bus back to the corner of King and Roslyn Streets.
