# SKY HIGH & GALAXIES ROOMS, LEVEL 2 (Lift access) CANTERBURY PARK RACECOURSE



**PUBLIC TRANSPORT** Canterbury Railway Station is about 1 km from the venue. The 413 Bus runs from Wynyard, Town Hall, Railway Square or Lewisham railway station. The 491 bus runs between Ashfield and Canterbury railway stations. Consult www.131500.com.au for details.

**PARKING** Free parking is available at the venue's front door.

**CATERING** A free self serve tea and coffee facility will be available in the playing area. Lunch may be ordered, with three menu options rotating daily. In addition a cafeteria will be open to

allow purchase of pies, sausage rolls, cakes and espresso coffee. A cash bar will be open for about an hour at the conclusion of play each day.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Persons applying to enter the Sydney Spring Nationals should be aware of the following:

- The Regulating Authority (the Australian Bridge Federation) reserves the right to refuse admission to any player who is not in good standing with any registered bridge club, bridge association or the Regulating Authority.
- No entry will be regarded as complete unless an entry has been submitted before the closing date, Friday 14 October 2016, with full entry fees paid and ABF numbers supplied. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser.
- 3. All players resident in Australia must be current financial members of the ABF Masterpoint Scheme.
- 4. Players born on or after 1/1/1991 receive a 50% rebate on their entry fees to all events.
- 5. All session times in this brochure are provisional and may be altered by the organisers as necessary to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the responsibility of players to be aware of the starting times of the sessions and rounds as announced by the Director and posted on the notice board.
- Mobile phones and other means of electronic communication must be switched off whilst in the playing area. Penalties will apply for non-compliance (see ABF Tournament Regulations, Section 19.1).
- 7. Players reaching the semi-finals or finals of the Open, Women's or Seniors' Teams must lodge their mobile phones (or other electronic communication devices) with the Tournament Director (or Tournament Organiser) who will secure them, along with the owner's name for safe keeping during each session.
- 8. Systems permitted in the various events are determined in accordance with the ABF Tournament Regulations, <a href="http://www.abfevents.com.au/events/tournregs/ABFTournRegs012\_updated.pdf">http://www.abfevents.com.au/events/tournregs/ABFTournRegs012\_updated.pdf</a>.
- 9. Pairs must have two copies of their system card on the table at every session

#### PLAYOFF QUALIFYING POINTS

PQPs are awarded according to ABF regulations to players who are eligible. Detailed information about PQPs and entry to the Australian Team Playoff is published only on the ABF website.

#### **OPEN EVENTS**

All systems and conventions are permitted except that systems classified as YELLOW are not permitted in the Seniors' Teams or the Open Pairs.
