- **'Excellent'**: a result that Australia has often not achieved in the modern era.
- **'Great'**: the best result that Australia has achieved or could have achieved in the modern era.
- **'Good'**: the team was close to achieving a 'Great' result but didn't quite get there.
- **'Fair'**: a middling result. Definitely nothing to write home about, but not an embarrassment.
- **'Below'**: roughly Australia's bottom third of results, on average. The team has under-performed.

Note: For some teams the number of data points is quite small.
