Travel

AIR: If you quote the ABF's Ansett master file
account number XP02164, you will receive full
flexibility to book at the last minute and to
change departure dates, with 50% off the full
economy fare (about the same cost as the
normal Advance Purchase flights).

BUS/TRAIN: Dial-a-Coach at 1800-020-007
(e.g. Sydney-Canberra return \$46-20 for full-
time students). Bus and train travellers will be
met at Canberra station by prior arrangement.
Train line goes only to Sydney.

CAR: For lifts from Sydney, contact Peter Gill.
From Barry Drive, enter ANU at traffic lights
via North Rd. Take first right into Daley Rd &
Burton and Garran is about 500m on the right.
From Clunies-Ross St, enter ANU via Dickson
Rd. Turn left into Daley Rd and Burton and
Garran Hall buildings are on your left.

Details

Eligibility: If you are not born on or after 1/1/85 and would like to take part, please contact the Convenor.

Trophies and prizes will be awarded to the winners in both the Pairs and the Teams, plus special prizes for younger players, and Certificates of Participation. The Delivera Cup will be awarded to the winners of the Teams.

Red Master Points will be awarded.

Snacks and soft drinks are provided free.

The party/barbecue is off-limits to the 17 to 29 year olds taking part in the Australian Youth Championships. Parents and/or friends of players who'd like to come to the party will be charged \$10 to cover costs.

The atmosphere at the Under 16 bridge games is relaxed and easy-going, with the emphasis on the players enjoying a pleasant game of bridge. Participants should be capable of completing a hand of bridge within 10 to 12 minutes. The supervisors will be Dorothy Jesner, Peter Gill and Brad Coles. Players are expected to make their own bids and plays.

Venue

Burton and Garran Hall, Daley Rd, Australian National University, Canberra
The entrance to the Playing Area is at the north-west corner of the central building of the Burton and Garran complex.

Cost (inclusive of GST)

One day: \$20 per person (includes party)

Two days: \$25 per person (includes party)

All fees preferably payable at the start of play.

A separate brochure about the Under 30 Australian Youth Championships from January 15-19 is available on request.

The Australian Youth Pairs Championship on January 15-16 is four full sessions at 1-30pm & 7-30pm on the Monday, with a Final and Consolation at 10-30pm & 2-30pm on the Tuesday. As the full event with the late finish on Monday should be too gruelling for Under 16s, the Consolation on the Tuesday may be entered at \$15 per pair. With the top half of the field in the Final, the bridge in the Consolation Pairs shouldn't be too demanding.

For any interstate players who decide to stay until Tuesday, on request we will provide an outing on Monday, e.g to the National Science Centre's special Movie Technology Show, using Burton and Garran Hall's minibus if needed. Local Canberra players are welcome.

Any Under 16 players who would like to play bridge for a couple of hours in the Teams event on Wed/Thurs 17-18 January should contact Peter Gill to see if there are any vacancies. The Board-a-Match Youth Teams on Friday Jan 19th at \$5 per player is another possibility.
