The first session of play, starting 1:30pm Sat 9th Jan, will be at Canberra Bridge Club, then we will move out to Greenhills.

However, this coming year **accommodation will also be provided at Greenhills for the initial Saturday night**. This has meant a corresponding increase in the package cost for the full week, which is inclusive of the bridge, shared accommodation and three meals a day (**see further down for costs**).

As always, it is also possible to come for just the Pairs (Sat/Sun), Teams (Mon/Tue) or side events (Wed/Thu/Fri).

The 10 pairs who play in the butler play-off to select the Australian U-26 team (Wed/Thu/Fri + Sat for 4 of the pairs*) will qualify from the Teams event in the same way as previous years. While they play the butler, fun events will be held alongside for everyone else. U-26 means born on or after 01/01/1984.

Best is to enter as pairs / teams-of-4 and I encourage everyone to organise their own partnerships for both events, but if you don't have a partner or team you can send us an email individually

(use <u>youthweek@abf.com.au</u>) and we'll sort out a partner / team-mates for you.

[Note: teams-of-5 or teams-of-6 are also able to play in the teams event, but only teams of 4 eligible players, or eligible pairs who play *every* session of the teams together, are able to qualify for the U-26 selection butler. In the case of such eligible pairs, it is not necessary that the pairs' teammates also be eligible.]
