Flying Agenda - Future Use of Flying Agenda

Order of agenda Jesner, Robb, Lusk, Stern and Gill then present to all for further comments. Format will be: each member sent an original form of the agenda with a list of order of comments and dates by which the document must be sent on. Onus is placed on the NEXT receiver to chase up the agenda by the date they should have received it. Aim for fast turn around

Definition Youth & Junior WBF Australian bridge scene

Decision to change terminology to be in line with WBF and ACBL. Categories will be Under 30, Junior (under 26), Youth (under 20) All event names will need to be changed accordingly. As well as the committee name, website features, bulletin name etc. PG to contact ABF with new terminology

Friends of Junior Bridge Sources of funding (cf USA Friends of Bridge)

To be a source of general junior funds, independent of ABF money - not to be used for coordinator fees or representation in PABF or WJC. To be basically used to extend the youth program beyond the current and existing ABF capabilities.

Funds to be held by the ABF for tax purposes but to be administered by the Junior Committee. In the event that the Junior Committee is disbanded then any funds at that time are to continue for youth bridge under the administration of one ABF representative and two representatives not then on the ABF.

DL to draft email KMcD with concept – DS to approved draft

DL to write letter to ABF for organisation of account – ABFJC to approved draft

DL to write letter to potential sponsors – ABFJC to approved draft

PG to identify potential sponsors

Location Friends of Junior Bridge - Sydney logical

To be a national initiative however envisaged that a number of potential sponsors are based in Sydney so many thrusts may be through this region

ABF Junior Bridge Club

Change club name to Junior. For under 19yr old players

<u>ABF Junior Bridge Club Membership</u> Currently stands at 22 from ACT and SA

ABF Junior Bridge Club Publicity

DL press release for Junior Bridge Club - ABTA and ABF Newsletters, AB, ABF and State Websites, and interested individuals (eg Christine Hadaway)

International Events Identify events for which we will be sending teams and formulate approximate budget for ABF purposes

Aim to send teams to HERO in even years with low international commitments. 7 people to WJC (Europe or Sth America), 7 people to PABF, Trans-Tasman Test Match (TTM)

DL ask ABF to underwrite a team to play in NZ nationals but plan to fundraise subsidies

DL/PG to formulate an approximate budget for ABF purposes

Will NZ NOT test match be repeated?

Yes - probably with a similar format to 2000

PG to organise free entry to NOT for NZ team from TTM with J Scudder

KR to ask Robin Young about possibility of 2 NZ teams for TTM

Establish criteria for team selection to each TTM event

2001 selection method for Aust. team for PABF and WJC selected as 2000 format (teams event of 4, third pair nominated by team desirable to be from second team)

PG and DL to nominate a team for TTM with a preference given to pairs rather than individual top players and aimed at giving experience to potential 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} Australian teams rather than likely representatives for 2001. ABFJC to approve

ANC General ANC Issues

All states and territories participating except NT DL to prepare recommendation from committee to states on eligibility to bring uniformity - request states adopt policy, if not provide details of existing policies

Include a proof of age form with entries of ANC junior teams in future years
