PUBLIC TRANSPORT

ACCOMMODATION

There is no accommodation within walking distance of the venue. Interstate teams may find it beneficial to hire a car and drive to the venue where free parking is available.

The **Comfort Inn & Suites** at Burwood Heights is located about 4 km from the venue. This hotel provides a courtesy bus to the venue in the morning and a return trip to the hotel after play ends. In the City

If staying in the CBD is more to your liking then the train from Museum Station or Central Station to Canterbury Station takes 20 - 25 minutes and runs every 15 minutes. It is a pleasant 15 - 20 minute walk (about 1 km) from the station to the venue or you can catch the 491 bus from the station to the corner of King and Roslyn Streets.

Alternatively, the 413 bus runs from Town Hall down George St through Railway Square and on to the venue taking 30 minutes. It runs every 30 minutes but note that on Sunday there are no services that will arrive at the venue before play.



The ABF has negotiated preferential rates at various Toga hotels and serviced apartments in Sydney, see www.abf.com.au/member-services/membership-benefits/accommodation-offers/. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Persons applying to enter the Australian National Championships should be aware of the following:

- 1. The Regulating Authority (The Australian Bridge Federation) reserves the right to refuse admission to any player who is not in good standing with any affiliated bridge club, any State Association, the Regulating Authority or any other national bridge organisation.
- No entry to the Open or Women's Butler Championships will be regarded as complete unless an entry form has been submitted before the closing date, Sunday 30th June 2014, with full entry fees paid and ABF numbers supplied. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser.
- All players resident in Australia must be current financial members of the ABF Masterpoint Scheme.
- 4. Players born on or after 1/1/1989 receive a 50% rebate on their entry fees to all events at the Australian National Championships.
- 5. All session times in this brochure are provisional and may be altered by the organisers as necessary to ensure the smooth running of the event. It is the responsibility of players to be aware of the starting times of the sessions and rounds as announced by the Director and posted on the notice board.
- 6. During session times mobile phones and other means of electronic communication must be switched off whilst in the playing area. Penalties will apply for non-compliance (see ABF Tournament Regulations, Section 19.1).
- 7. Players reaching the finals of the Open, Women's, Seniors' or Youth Teams must lodge their mobile phones (or other electronic communication devices) with the Tournament Director (or Tournament Organiser) who will secure them, along with the owner's name for safe keeping during each session.

Important Notice Australian Women's Butler Pairs Championship

If fewer than 30 pairs enter the Australian Women's Butler Championship, then it will be a single stage round robin event of 12 board matches, 5, 4 or 3 per day over the six day period, Sat 19 – Thu 24 July. In this case an additional entry fee of \$420 per pair will be payable on Monday 21 July.

If a Women's pair wishes to play on the weekend only they may opt to play in the Open Butler – Stage I or the Flighted Butler – Open division.

CANTERBURY GUINEAS CONGRESS EVENTS

The Canterbury Guineas Congress is named after a Group One horse race held at Canterbury Park Racecourse from 1935 to 2005.

A guinea was a gold coin circulating in the Colony until 1812 when the Holey Dollar was introduced by Governor Macquarie. Worth one pound and one shilling, the guinea continues to be used in selling of livestock where the one shilling often represents the agent's commission. Its conversion rate on the 14 February, 1966 was \$2.10.

During the first week there are two congress events available to contestants in the Interstate Teams, the Under Starter's Orders Open Swiss Pairs on Saturday 12 July and the Champagne Stakes Swiss Pairs on Friday 18 July.
