How lazy play can be your undoing (BAWA Open Teams)

After three passes East opens 1H. West now upgrades his hand with a good long Club suit and responds 2C. East now bids 2NT which in their system is stronger than straight to 3NT.

West knows there is a good chance his long club suit plus the Diamond Ace is good for at least 9 tricks.

On the lead of the Diamond 3, declarer runs this to his Q. Now as any bridge teacher will tell you, 'plan your play'. East plays the Club K and overtakes with the Ace and immediately plays the Club J. North wins and returns a small Spade to declarer's 10, J, 8. Another Spade from south which North takes with his Ace. Declarer can now claim 10 tricks.

At the other table the pair also finished in 3NT. However, declarer was lazy and let the K of clubs ride. It is all over now as his A of Diamonds is the only entry to the Clubs which has not yet been established and therefore is not enough to be successful.

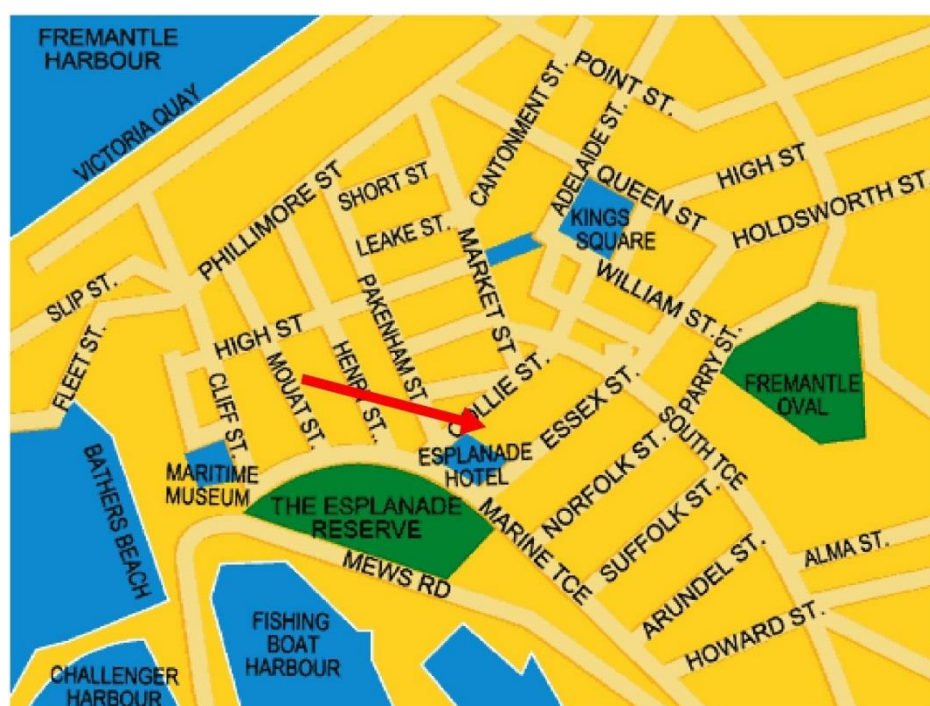
