With a strong demand for parking in the CBD the City of Fremantle is working to ensure equitable access for everyone by providing short, medium and long term parking options.

Fremantle residents can also obtain permits that provide for free parking from 9am-11am and 3pm-1am Monday to Friday for on-street parking. Conditions apply, contact 9432 9999 for more information.

Short Term Parking

- ½ hour free parking in High St (west of Market Street).
- 1056 on-street car parking bays right outside banks, post office and stores in the CBD.

Medium Term Parking

- Not sure how long you will be? Queensgate Car Park has 850 spaces right in the heart of the City.

Long Term Parking

- Cheaper long term parking is located on the fringes of the CBD, try Beach St, Ellen St, and Parry St Car Parks.

Universal Access

An Acrod Permit allows free parking in City of Fremantle car parks and 30 minutes over the time limit (except time limits shown on dedicated Acrod bays). For a map of ramps and pathways go to the 'getting around' page on www.fremantle.wa.gov.au
