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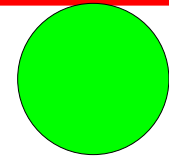

## PRE-ALERTS: CALLS THAT MAY HAVE UNEXPECTED MEANING/S OR REQUIRE SPECIAL DEFENCE

Inverted minors      4m=preempt in m + 4 cd M

1♣, 2♣= 11-14 or 18+      CMOBDOR takeout of preempts

Transfers after (X) of M      Transfer responses after 1M-(X)-may be limit
