	- When preemptor leads a side suit



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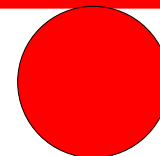

PRE-ALERTS: CALLS THAT MAY HAVE UNEXPECTED MEANING/S OR REQUIRE SPECIAL DEFENCE

1♣=16+ any; many relays	1♠=4+♥/4+♠; 2♣ response
1♦=4+♠, denies 4♥; 1♥/♠ response	1NT denies either major
1♥=4+♥, denies 4♠; 1♠ response	Transfer responses to overcalls
