## 267. Help from the enemy

Dealer South: Both vulnerable

North


West North East South 1NT **2**♥<sup>(2)</sup> **3♣**<sup>(3)</sup> Dble<sup>(1)</sup> 3♠ All Pass Pass 4♠ (1) Hearts and a minor

- (2) Transfer to spades
- (3) Pass or correct

West leads the ◆A: three – four (reverse count) – nine. West switches to the ◆4: three – ace – five. East returns the **\vec{4}**. Plan the play.

The opposition here has helped you. Without it, you could be tempted to take the heart finesse. With West's double showing hearts, you can be sure the heart finesse will fail. That would be the third trick for the defence and you can be sure that the ◆K will take trick four for one down. What can you do to make the contract?

Dealer South: Both vulnerable



After ♦A lead, ♣4 to East's ♣A and the ♥4 switch, South took the ♥A and played the ♠3: queen – king – two and the ♣9: six – ten – two. South cashed the ♣K, discarding the ♥9 from dummy. Then came the ♥Q: king – ♠10 – **♥2**, the ♠J and the ♠4 to the ♠A. South lost ♦A, ♣A and ♦K, but had ten tricks for +620.

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East led the ♥4: queen – king. West switched to the ◆K. Declarer made 9 tricks, +140, but –10 Imps.
